NOTICE OF ELECTION

On **April 14, 2021**, members from the following Districts will elect new members to the Council of the College of Early Childhood Educators:

- 3 – South East Region (one Council member)
- 4 – Central East Region (two Council members)
- 8 – South West Region (two Council members)

Council is composed of 14 member-elected Registered Early Childhood Educators and 10 members of the public who are appointed by the Ontario government. Council members play an active role in shaping the future of the profession. Their work to regulate early childhood educators in the public interest supports the provision of high-quality early learning and care for Ontario's children.

Diversity is a key component of effective leadership; if you're an RECE who is Black, Indigenous or a Person of Colour, consider running for a position on Council. Your unique experiences and perspectives add to Council's ability to navigate the complexities of governing a profession as unique as the children and families it supports.
